

fix, set and turn your partner quite round, right and left at top.

No. XIX.—*Irish Washwoman.*

Round right hands across, back again, down the middle, up again, cast off, six hands round, right and left.

No. XX.—*Scotch Bonnet.*

Change sides, back, down the middle, up again, and cast off one couple.

No. XXI.—*Maid of the Oak.*

The first lady sets to the second gentleman, turns the third, the gentleman does the same, down the middle, up again, cast off one couple, right and left.

No. XXII.—*Merry go round.*

The first lady turn the second gentleman, the first gentleman then turn the second lady, down the middle, up again, cast off, right and left.

No. XXIII.—*College Hornpipe.*

Cast off three couple, up the middle, same time the third couple up the middle and down the outside, first and second couple hands round half way and back, down the middle, up again, right and left.

Irish Washwoman
6 couples in lines
3 couples to a set
Instructions for each set

1. All 3 couples join right hands, 1/2 way round clockwise, Reverse + return
2. Top couple in each set join hands dance down + back up
3. Top couple cast off to bottom of set. others step up one place
4. All join hands, dance clockwise. All reverse, return to place

* *Maid of the Oak*

SO SIMPLE!

"Strip the willow" down + back up
Top couple ONLY casts off to bottom.

Merry go round

4 couples

- 1st lady, 2nd Man turn
- 1st man, 2nd lady turn
- 1st lady + man sashay down + up
- 1st lady + man cast off all follow -
- 1st couple remain @ bottom - others three + stop til 2nd couple becomes 1st.
